Dear Applicants:

Thank you for your interest in joining the Law Enforcement Team at the White County Indiana Sheriff's Department.

Modern challenges in law enforcement require officer candidates to sustain the rigors and demands of law enforcement service, both physically and mentally, in order to provide the service that our citizens expect from public safety personnel. To that end, in 1999, the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy began using new physical fitness assessment standards. As part of the application process, a Physical Assessment Test will be conducted. All applicants will be expected to meet the following goals in order to continue the application process. These goals will replace all others previously used in the testing procedures.

The White County Sheriffs Department strongly suggests you consult your physician if you have any concerns regarding your physical capability or conditioning. You will be required to sign a medical liability release form at the time of testing.

On **Saturday April 1, 2017, at 9:00 am**, all applicants will report to the Twin Lakes High School Wrestling Room with a valid driver's license, prepared to sign a medical waiver of liability and complete the physical assessment test. The applicant should have the proper clothing for the weather conditions as some tests will be conducted outdoors. Each applicant will be required to pass the following tests that will be conducted in no certain order:

Test	Passing Standard
Vertical Jump	16 inches
Sit-Ups	29 completed in one minute or less
300 Meter Run	Completed in 71 seconds or less
Push-Ups	25 completed
1.5 Mile Run	Completed in 16 minutes and 28 seconds or less
Dummy Drag	Pull or carry 100 lb dummy 25 feet without stopping
Vehicle Push	Push a stopped police cruiser 50 feet without stopping

On **Saturday April 1, 2017, at 12:00 pm**, applicants who have successfully passed the physical assessment test will report to the IU Health White Memorial Hospital conference room for a written test. The conference room faces 6th Street and is on the south end of the hospital.
