PRIME for Life

Prime is a drug and alcohol education class. It is a risk reduction program to help participants reduce the risk for any type of drug or alcohol problem. It is not a replacement for “Intensive Outpatient Therapy”.

This program is for first and second time offenders of drugs and/or alcohol. It is not for persons with addictions to drugs or alcohol.

The requirements for White County Community Corrections “Prime for Life” program are:

- Minimum score of 12 on the LSI-R risk assessment.
- Involved in the following programs: Incarcerated, House Arrest, Work Release, Day Reporting, and Supervised/Unsupervised Probation.
- Referred by the Courts, Probation Department, Community Corrections, Indiana Department of Child Service, and Wabash Valley out Patient service.
- Not currently enrolled in IOP.
